 - b. Treasurer Report
 - i. Current bank balance as of 3/11/25 is \$24,841.34 Debits include but are not limited to Wolves tickets fees and MS Scholastic Book Fair book fee. Deposits include but are not limited to Night on the Town, Wolves ticket sales, MS book fair sales and local merchant checks. At last year's budget meeting the Fun Day budget was decreased by \$1,000 due to lack of overall PTO funds. However since local merchant events have been successful this year we have agreed to increase the Fun Day budget back up to its original amount from \$2,000 to \$3,000. A motion was made in favor of this increase by Katrina & voted on by the board with a final vote of 4 yes and 0 no.
