## k. Summer Fundraiser

- i. OUTFOXED! You may spot some adorable & friendly foxes around town soon! Thank you to J4 Graphics for donating the campaign signs that will go along with the foxes! The first 3 homes will be surprised with foxes in their yard! Those families will have 3 different options. They may do nothing and the foxes will be gone in 3 days, email the committee & the foxes will be gone asap or you may fill out the google form and send foxes to someone else in town! For \$25 you can send 5 foxes, for \$50 you can send 10 foxes and for \$100 for 25 foxes & for a donation of \$10 or more you may keep 1 fox! - ii. Environmental Fundraiser: Julia is looking into 2 different organizations that collect old shoes. One organization resells the good shoes and recycles/donates the yucky ones. We would have to register with the state of Illinois as a charitable organization in their charitable trust database. This costs \$15 each you & you must do it every year or face a fine of \$200.00. This shoe organization has us collecting 25 pairs of shoes per bag

and a truck will come and pick them up. They want us to collect at least 1,000 pairs of shoes and we get paid by weight or about \$1 per pair (40 cents per pound). If we collect over 1000 pairs we would get 55 cents per pound. If we do not hit the 1000 pairs of shoes, we must pay \$250 for the truck to come out and pick up the shoes which comes out of the amount we would have been paid. The second organization collects wearable shoes only. They pay out by the condition of the shoes. \$3 to \$1 per pair depending on condition and brand. They have another option for worn shoes which is 25 cents per pair. There is no minimum and they send boxes that ship paid for by the company. This second option has no risk as we do not have to register with the state of IL or have any minimum number of shoes to collect. Something to think about, no need to make a decision today. Further discussion can be at our next meetings.
