2. Treasurer Report; Michael Campbell

a. Our current bank balance is \$28,210. The Spring Fling committee did very well this year bringing in \$15,000 for the PTO which is right on target after expenses. Fun Day committee will be looking at getting a refund for the deposit that was made since Fun Day has been canceled for this year. There will be no ARS book fair either which will change the budget slightly however the \$800 that is allocated for the ARS library will be held for the 2020-2021 school year to be spent. Checks should still be coming in for our after school programs. Amazon Smile is up this year and doing very well. Please continue to use amazon smile while making purchases thru amazon. The budget for Teacher Appreciation has been increased this year. Even if we go back to school in May, there will not be ample time to prepare for Teacher Appreciation week. Instead all district 3 staff will be receiving a Panera gift card to show our appreciation for all the hard work they do for our students. As for the proposed budget for the 2020-2021 school year the following changes have been made. Amazon Smile has been increased to \$250.00, field trip per student is now \$7 an increase of \$2 from last year, the ARS KM scholarship fund has increased to \$500 to help more families in need in the district, local merchant will decrease to \$500 due to economic downfall, ice cream social at ARS has been removed, and the teacher start up grants will increase to \$75. The proposed budget for the 2020-2021 school year will be posted on the website for individuals to comment on & then the board will vote on it at the next PTO meeting.
