As part of our efforts to promote and maintain financial responsibility, the PTO has instituted a new policy regarding checks issued by the PTO. At their October 6, 2015 meeting, the Fox River Grove PTO Board voted unanimously to institute the following policy regarding checks written by the PTO, effective immediately:

- Any check written on or before December 31, 2014 shall be null and voided.
- Checks written from January 1, 2015 until present will have until December 31, 2015 to be cashed.
- As of January 1, 2016 all checks will have 90 days from the date printed on the check to be cashed.

FRG PTO partners with the Fox River Grove Rec Council and School District 3 in supporting enhancements to social emotional learning program...

As part of Fox River Grove School District 3 PBIS and RtI initiative for social emotional learning, we will be enhancing our middle school curriculum with additional resources from a local community agency. In addition to the Second Step lessons all students are receiving in the classroom, we have partnered with Cjay Harmer of Pioneer Center for Human Services to bring classroom based presentations on bullying and relational issues.

Mr. Harmer is a Prevention Specialist and an expert in the field, who we have been fortunate to have in our district for the past two years. He has a booming presence and creates a positive, upbeat atmosphere that makes students feel comfortable to share experiences and break through social barriers. As we move into the school year we will be working with Cjay to provide additional proactive intervention services for students during lunch. These groups will focus on specific topics and issues that impact student learning.

Cjay pulls from a wide knowledge base and utilizes preventive programs he's been certified to deliver. His expertise will lend to our interventions at the Tier 2 and Tier 3 levels of the PBIS and RtI frame work.
