Ш	As part of our efforts to promote and maintain financial responsibility, the PTO has
	instituted a new policy regarding checks issued by the PTO. At their October 6, 2015
	meeting, the Fox River Grove PTO Board voted unanimously to institute the following
	policy regarding checks written by the PTO, effective immediately:
	<ul> <li>Any check written on or before December 31, 2014 shall be null and voided.</li> <li>Checks written from January 1, 2015 until present will have until December 31, 2015 to be cashed.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>As of January 1, 2016 all checks will have 90 days from the date printed on the check to be cashed.</li> </ul>
