

Register/log in at School Shopping Made Simple, Supplies at Bargain Prices - School Tool Box

- Shop on-line (teacher approved lists provided)
- Customize your order (only order supplies you need e.g., if you already have the correct size scissors you can remove them and save money)
- Your order ships right to your home for free with orders over \$50
- To receive the kits in time for Middle School locker check (8/17), you should order before July 27.
- To receive the kits in time for the first day of school (8/24), you should order before August 3.

For the 2016/17 school year, the PTO will purchase 66 kits for District 3 students in need. The total cost for the kits is \$3113. The <u>FRG Lionesses</u> have <u>GENEROUSLY</u> DONATED \$1750 TO HELP COVER THE COSTS OF THESE KITS!

If you would like to make a monetary donation to help purchase a kit, you can do so through this website. You will need to register/log in, add your child, pick a box/kit and then click customize. If you scroll to the bottom you will see the option to donate \$1, \$5, \$10 or \$25. Just make sure to check the box.
