Business

- 1. PTO Elections: Jen Gipson
 - a. Thank you the Jen Gipson for putting together our 2019-2020 PTO elections. Voting took place by board members, teachers & parents who attended the meeting. Jen then tallied up the votes and results were read at the end of the meeting.

- 3. Treasurer Report; Michael Campbell
 - a. Thank you to the committee that met to propose the 2019-2020 budget. Copies of the budget were available at the meeting for all to view. Many items on the budget were broken up into their own line item to be able to keep better record of money going out. These include but not limited to: Accounting software, bank fees, copies at ups, tax/audit fees and email software license. Family engagement, MS Digital Safety Program, and MS Health Program were all new line items added to the 2019-2020 budget. Budget was approved by the board with a 5 to 0 vote. Bank balance for this month is \$30,000 based on that we will have a \$10,000 allocation back to the school district. Mrs. McKenzie & Dr.Ozimek have been working together to spend that money appropriately for new materials for the schools. The board has agreed that any extra money after teacher start up grants are paid out that money will go into a CD that would help us in case of a bad year for the PTO. Congrats to the Mother Son Committee for coming up \$35 ahead on their budget this year!

- 1. PTO Budget 2019-2020 School Year
 - a. Budget was approved 5 to 0 for the 2019-2020 school year.
- 2. Grant Requests
 - a. Susan Pettigrew is requesting a 3D printer, 6 spools of filament and shipping costs for a total of \$828.00. This grant will be used by 5th to 8th graders for Maker Space class. Grant was approved by the board 6 to 0.
 - b. Jacki O'Mara is requesting supplies to help maintain the for the tower gardens for the 7th and 8th grade science classes. The total cost for the supplies is \$270.17. Grant was approved by the board 6 to 0.
 - c. The 1st grade team are requesting 2 block seating rugs for the 1st grade rooms. The total cost of the rugs are \$899.98. Grant was approved by the board 6 to 0.

- ARS Book Fair: Sales this year were \$6400 which is a \$1000 less than last year. That resulted in using \$311 of the profit to purchase books for the ARS library. ARS will also be receiving a check for \$487.00 also to be used for library items. The PTO will receive a check for \$900 from the book fair profit. Overall book fair went very smoothly, Scholastic sent us less items this year which could of been one of the reasons profits were lower this year.
